2024 Application Guide

The Yokohama International Student House (YISH) is not only a residence for international students, but is also a place which seeks to establish cultural exchange with local citizens and school students. Residents can experience Japanese culture and social life through YISH events. We provide a variety of activities that encourage residents to make friends with international students and spread the harmony of friendship all around the world.

1 Expected Number of Rooms Available

【 International Students 】

Single Room··· about 30 Rooms

Family Room··· 4 Rooms

【 Resident Assistant (RA) 】

Single Room··· 4 Rooms

2 Requirements for Move-in Application

(Accepted applicants must attend “the Contract and Guidance Program for New Residents” to be held in February or March. In case of absence your name will be put on a waiting list.)

【 International Students 】

Single Room / Family Room : University Students who are enrolled in Junior College Program, Graduate School Masters’ Program, Doctorate Program or specialized courses at a specialty/vocational institution in the Yokohama city and have a “college student” visa (including those expected to enroll in April, 2024).

* Those who do not meet the requirements: Auditor students, research students, pre-college students, Short-term international student and students engaged in specialized research courses

※ Those who can live with the international student in a family room include: spouse and children with “dependent,” or “college student,” visas.

【 Resident Assistant (RA) 】

Single Room: Japanese University students or University Students having permanent resident visa in Japan, who are enrolled in Junior College Program, Graduate School Masters’ Program, Doctorate Program or specialized courses at a specialty/vocational school in the Yokohama city.

* Those who do not meet the requirements: Auditor students, research students, pre-college students and students engaged in specialized research courses

《 Role of RA 》

- Actively participate and cooperate in events held at the Yokohama International Student House.
- Support exchange activities of international students.
- Bridging International students so that they can make new friends in the YISH.
- Explain about Japanese customs/culture and try to solve misunderstandings that may arise from daily life activities.
- Cooperate with the operation of YISH.

3 YNU application documents submission period

Tuesday, December 5 through Friday, January 12, 2024 Closing at 17:00

* When you miss the YNU deadline, you may submit the application documents by yourself to Yokohama City International Student House (YISH). Please ask your academic affairs section for a YNU official stamp on a recommendation letter and submit a set of application documents to YISH no later than 17:00 on January 27. 5 Documents to be submitted

Please correctly fill out the forms accurately according to the sample form “How to fill the Application Documents.” Please arrange the documents in the order from (1) as follows, and staple in the upper left hand side of the page :

- (1) Application Forms for Single and Family Rooms (Form 2)
- (2) Recommendation Letter (Form 3) *The top right area **should be blank** for the university to be completed.
- (3) Questionnaire regarding Cultural Exchange Activities
(for international student and RA)
- (4) Copy of Residence Card and Student ID card (only for International Students)
- (5) Copy of Residence Card and Student ID card (of family) (only for family room)
- (6) Copy of Notification of Acceptance from a university or institute (only for applicants who have been accepted and are expected to enroll the university or institute in April 2024)
- (7) Envelope for reply (Put an 84-yen postal stamp and write your name and an address in Japan to receive the notification of results on February 14th, 2024).

6. Notification of Results for Acceptance of Residents

Residents are decided by the “Yokohama International Student House Resident Acceptance Committee.” The results will be sent to the applicants directly, on February 8th, 2024 (with the envelope for sending your decision to us). We will also send the results to the respective Universities or institutes.

7. Interview

Only applicants for RA will have attend interview before deciding the acceptance of residents.

8 Monthly Rent and Room Facilities

Single Room: 20,000 yen per month (Size 18 m²)

Family Room: 30,000 yen per month (Size 38 m²)

- * Neither a deposit, “Thank you” fee, nor management fee are required. Residents have to pay electricity bills individually.
- * There is a bed, unit bath/shower, fridge, air conditioner, small kitchen, and curtains in each room.

9 Other expenses

- ◇ **Water and hot water charge** (flat fee) Single room: **3,400 yen** per month
Family room: **4,600 yen** per month
- ◇ **Room Cleaning Charge** (after your leaving) Single room: **22,000 yen**
Family room: **33,000 yen**
- ◇ **Internet costs** **10,000 yen** per year
- ◇ **Residents' Association membership fee** **3,000 yen** per year

You should reply that you will live in our house or not by 15th Feb. No reply means cancel.

• Move In

1st April

You can move-in from this day, but after asking the desirable date we will appoint the specific day and time of your move in.

• **Welcome Party** 6th April (Saturday) 15:00~

11 Residency Period

The period of stay is from April 1, 2024 to March 28, 2025.

Residents who meet the qualifications for residency may have their stay extended for another year.
※However, the move-out deadline may be changed depending on cleaning and building maintenance.

Any personal information on your application form will be used solely for the application procedure. However, please take note that the application procedure also includes the submission of this personal information to your university or institutes.

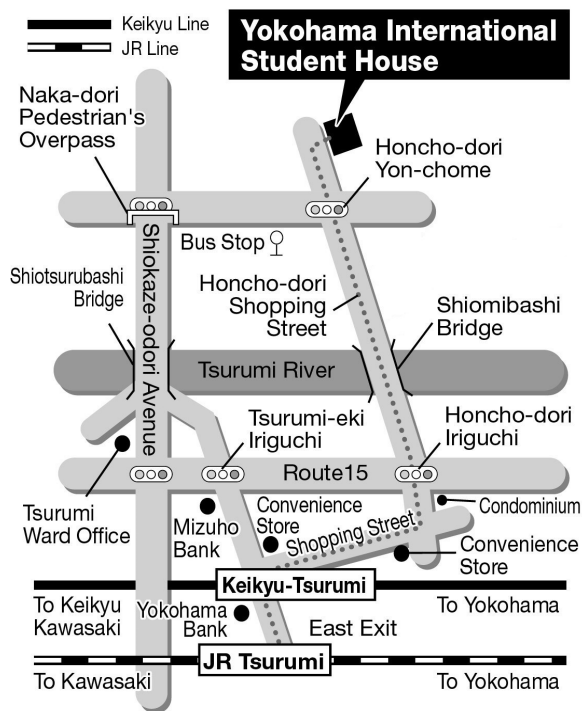
