

## Notice regarding the Off-campus Health Exams

For those who were unable to take the 2026 Student Regular Health Checkup (on-campus health checkup from April 8th to April 21st), please refer to the following information on off-campus health checkup institutions.

【Place】 44-9, 2-chome, Tenno-cho, Hodogaya-ku, Yokohama (3 min. walk from Tennocho Station, Sotetsu Line)

【Fee】 2,585 yen for the same items as the on-campus health checkup

【Note】

- ◇ You must make a reservation by telephone in advance (046-262-8155). Tell them you are a YNU student.
- ◇ If you have a fever or are feeling unwell, you may not be able to take the health check.
- ◇ Be sure to bring your student ID card with you on the day of the health check.
- ◇ The results of your health checkup will be available at the Kenshin Centre approximately 3 weeks later. If you would like to have the results sent to you by mail, please contact the Kenshin Center. If you require a health certificate, please contact the Kenshin Center (an additional fee of 3,300 yen will be charged for issuing a certificate).

【Place】 43-1, Kamadai-cho, Hodogaya-ku, Yokohama (5 min. walk from the west gate of YNU campus)

【Fee】 4,400 yen for the same items as the on-campus health checkup; A Course (certificate fee is included)

【Note】

- ◇ You must make a reservation by telephone in advance (045-331-1251). Tell them you are a YNU student.
- ◇ If you have a fever or are feeling unwell, you may not be able to take the health check.
- ◇ Be sure to bring your student ID card with you on the day of the health check.
- ◇ The results and certificates in Japanese will be issued on the same day (it will take a few days to issue in English).

○If you have a health checkup at the other institution

Please tell them the items you need: height and weight measurement, vision test, hearing test (conversation method), blood pressure measurement, chest X-ray, urine test (protein, occult blood, sugar), and internal medical examination.

If you are a new student and have had a health checkup at an off-campus health institution, please submit a copy of the results to the university (administration department of your college or graduate school).
