Application Guidelines For The Special Tuition Waiver Program For Fall Semester of AY2023

(For International students who are facing sudden financial difficulties due to the spread of the COVID-19)

We will accept applications for the special tuition waiver program for Fall Semester of AY2023 for international students who are facing sudden financial difficulties to pay their tuition fees due to the spread of the COVID-19 as below.

Application Period : Friday, October 6, 2023 \sim Tuesday, October 31, 2023

©Eligibility

Privately financed international students who work or whose family work in Japan and pay tuition mainly based on their income in Japan ¹, and are able to prove that their income has decreased to less than half compared to that of 2019, 2020, 2021 or 2022 ² due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 1 "work in Japan and pay tuition mainly based on their income in Japan" means that, in principle, "income earned by working in Japan" accounts for more than half of the total income in the economic living situation before the sudden change in household finances. For example, if the remittance from parents is more than the income in Japan, it does not apply to "work in Japan and pay the tuition mainly based on the income in Japan".
- 2 "are able to prove that their income has decreased to less than half compared to that of 2019, 2020, 2021 or 2022" means to be able to prove that the estimated income in 2023 is less than half of the income in 2019, 2020, 2021 or 2022 which is stated on the municipality-issued tax exemption or taxation certificate. The estimated amount of income for 2023 is calculated by quadrupling the amount of income for the three months from July to September 2023.

ONotes

- Even if you meet the requirements for this special tuition waiver program, you are not guaranteed to be waived, as the assessment for this special waiver will be conducted under a limited budget just as with the regular tuition waiver program. Therefore, please check the amount of the tuition fee and payment deadlines in case the tuition waiver is not granted.
- Please fill in the application form without hiding the facts. If the contents of your application documents are found false, your application may be excluded from the examination or your waiver permission may be revoked.
- Unlike the regular tuition waiver program, this special tuition waiver program requires an application for each semester. If you wish to apply for the special tuition waiver program in the fall semester, please submit the required documents on the next page, "①Additional documents to prove your facing sudden financial difficulties", even if you applied to the special tuition waiver program in the spring semester.

Please submit the application documents within the designated application period by mail or in person as listed below.

Any applications that arrive after the application deadline, Tuesday, October 31, 2023, will not be accepted. Please write "Application for Special Tuition Waiver" in red on the front of the envelope.
